Running Edmark Reading Program Software on Mac

The Software installs and runs properly on Mac OSX 10.2, with a non-Intel chipset.

While the program appears to install on Intel Macs, and in particular on OS 10.5 and newer, PRO-ED is aware that there have been some issues with the program working properly, in particular regarding saving lessons.

We will address this issue in the next software update. There is no known interim fix for this issue.

Running Edmark Reading Program Software on Windows XP

PRO-ED is aware of a garbled sound issue with audio drivers for *some* recent audio chipsets. We hope to address this issue in the next software update. There is no known interim fix for this issue.

Administrator permissions / access are required to install the program on Windows XP.


Installing Edmark Reading Program on Windows Vista
