Functions: Card 1

What is this? *a bicycle*


What do you do with a bicycle? *ride it to go places, race, park it, clean it*

What parts does a bicycle have? wheels, handlebars, seat, tires, gears, chain, pedals

Why should you wear a helmet when you ride a bike? *to protect your head in case you fall off your bike*

What do you use to stop a bike? brakes, pedals

Where can you ride a bike? *in a street, on a sidewalk, in a park, on a playground*

Functions: Card 2

What is this? *a hammer*

What do you do with a hammer? pound nails into wood or boards, pry nails loose, beat metal

What parts does a hammer have? *handle, metal head*

What occupations use hammers? *builder, carpenter, electrician, plumber, metal worker, engineer, jeweler*

Why is a hammerhead usually made of strong metal? *so it can drive nails with force*

Where can you store a hammer? toolbox, cabinet, drawer, tool belt
